



## WHAT DOES SABLE DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security number</li> <li>• Account balances and transaction history</li> <li>• Employment information and assets</li> <li>• Credit and Payment information</li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons Sable chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>For our everyday business purposes—</b> such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s) and respond to court orders and legal investigations.	Yes	No

<b>For our affiliates’ everyday business purposes—</b> Information about your transactions and experiences	No	We do not share

<b>For nonaffiliates to market to you</b>	No	We do not share

What we do	
<b>How does Sable protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files. Our website uses cookies, but no personally identifiable information is stored within these cookies.
<b>How does Sable collect my personal information?</b>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Open an account and give us your identifying and contact information</li> <li>▪ Use your Sable debit card and make deposits and withdrawals from associated accounts</li> <li>▪ Use your Sable credit card and make payments from associated accounts</li> </ul> <p>We may also collect your personal information from other companies.</p>
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>▪ Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>▪ Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul>
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Sable does not have affiliates.</p>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Sable does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</p>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p>Sable does not do joint marketing</p>
